The Department of Environmental Protection received your request for information addressed to DEP Commissioner McCarthy, concerning the Newhall Street Neighborhood Remediation Project on September 1, 2006. Specifically, you requested:

1. A specific and complete cost breakdown of the final proposed Remediation Plan that you presented publicly on August 17, 2006. The total cost of the plan was estimated to be between \$62 million and \$72 million.
2. Digitized copies of any and all soil sampling data or reports for individual properties, and summary tables of said reports, in the Consent Order Area of the Newhall Remediation Project.

Enclosed with this letter are the materials you requested. Three paper copies of the cost breakdown are enclosed. Also, enclosed is a CD copy of each of the soil data and reports that we have electronically, including a list of the enclosed CDs.
