**FIRST QUARTER 2004 PROGRESS REPORT
JANUARY THROUGH MARCH 2004**

A concise summary of investigative actions completed during the first quarter of 2004 to comply with Consent Order No. SRD-128 is presented below. In addition, a list of actions proposed to be completed in the second quarter of 2004 is also shown below.

Actions Completed During First Quarter of 2004

- Completion of water-quality sampling round in February 2004 for all site wells installed by Leggette, Brashears and Graham, Inc. (LBG) during 2002 site investigation. Depth to water measurements were also collected from all available regional monitor wells. Ground-water monitor wells were sampled for volatile organic compounds, semi-volatile organic compounds, extractable total petroleum hydrocarbons, pesticides, polychlorinated biphenyls, priority pollutant metals plus vanadium, tin, cobalt, barium and cyanide.
- Updated internal water-quality database. In process of updating regional water-quality database, maps and creating additional regional ground-water flow map.
- Submitted updated quarterly water-quality results to Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection (CTDEP) for aid in reviewing 2002 investigation report.
- Oversaw Town of Hamden drilling of pylon boreholes on southeastern portion of Former New Haven Water Company parcel. Drilling was related to construction activities of temporary classrooms for the Hamden Middle School.
- Submitted electronic versions of 2002 investigation report and quarterly progress reports to CTDEP consultant (Fitzgerald and Halliday) for public use.
- At request of CTDEP, creating isopleth map of marine clays observed during 2002 investigation.
- Preparing response to CTDEP March 8, 2004 comments of 2002 investigation of former New Haven Water Company properties.

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Actions Proposed to be Completed During Second Quarter of 2004 (April through June 2004)


- Submit work plan to address data gaps identified by the South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority/LBG and CTDEP coming out of the work documented in the 2002 environmental site investigation report.
- Submit response to CTDEP March 8, 2004 comments of 2002 investigation of former New Haven Water Company properties.
- Submit updated water-quality and ground-water database to CTDEP; including regional potentiometric surface map.
- Develop work plan to investigate data gaps identified during 2002 investigation. Proposed work plan is scheduled to be presented to public in April.
