**FIRST QUARTER 2010 PROGRESS REPORT
JANUARY THROUGH MARCH 2010**

A summary of investigative actions completed during the first quarter of 2010 to comply with Consent Order No. SRD-128 is presented below.

Actions Completed During First Quarter of 2010


- Continued participation in Public Involvement Plan;
- Re-submittal of Focused Remedial Action Plan for Polychlorinated Biphenyls (PCBs) impacted soils located within the athletic field and west of tennis courts; and
- Submittal of Emergency or Temporary Authorization Discharge Permit for remediation of volatile organic compounds (VOCs) impacted soils located within the athletic field and west of tennis courts.

Actions Proposed to be Completed During Second Quarter of 2010 (April through June 2010)

- If CTDEP conditional approval is received, remediate PCB and VOC impacted soils located west of tennis courts. The schedule for the work would be contingent on timing of the approval letter(s), permit process and any potential conditions identified in the letter(s);
- Submittal of supplemental investigation report regarding soil investigations at Hamden Housing Authority property; and
- Continue participation in Public Involvement Plan.
