**FIRST QUARTER 2005 PROGRESS REPORT
JANUARY THROUGH MARCH 2005**

A summary of investigative actions completed during the first quarter of 2005 to comply with Consent Order No. SRD-128 is presented below. In addition, a list of actions proposed to be completed in the second quarter of 2005 is also shown below.

Actions Completed and to be Completed During First Quarter of 2005

- Completed field investigations described in 2004 Supplemental Scope of Study and subsequent approved addendum modifications;
- Pursuant to CTDEP request, completed additional field investigations relating to recollection of samples which were originally collected and analyzed during the 2002 field investigations. The samples have been submitted for analyses of polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbons (PAHs), and after review will be submitted for dioxin and furans analyses;
- Installed additional offsite ground-water monitor wells as described in the approved 2004 Supplemental Scope of Study and pursuant to the December 14, 2004 addendum modification submittal and January 14, 2005 CTDEP conditional approval letter;
- Completed offsite residential soil-vapor sampling. Submitted results of analyses for review to CTDEP and issued results to residents;
- Completion of water-quality sampling round which includes offsite wells; and
- Submittal of Final Investigation and Evaluation of Remedial Alternative Report

Actions Proposed to be Completed During Second Quarter of 2005 (April 2005 through June 2005)

- Submit addendum report characterizing occurrence of dioxin and furans present in materials containing polychlorinated biphenyls, halogenated volatile organic compound and PAHs; and
- Complete water-quality sampling round.


