A summary of investigative actions completed during the third quarter of 2007 to comply with Consent Order No. SRD-128 is presented below.

Actions Completed During Second Quarter of 2007

- Continued participation in Public Involvement Plan;
- Completion of quarterly sampling of ground water from wetland area north of Middle School Site. RWA has satisfied all sampling requirements identified in the CTDEP August 17, 2006 conditional approval;
- Collection and analyses of quarterly ground-water samples and residential soil-vapor samples related to offsite volatile organic compound (VOC) plume. RWA has satisfied all sampling requirements identified in the CTDEP August 17, 2006 conditional approval; and
- Submittal of Focused Remedial Action Plan for PCB impacted soils located west of tennis courts and responses to CTDEP comment regarding 2005 Final Investigation and Remedial Evaluation Report.

Actions Proposed to be Completed During Fourth Quarter of 2007 (October 2007 through December 2007)

- Submittal of letter report summarizing offsite soil-vapor and ground-water investigations results described in the August 17, 2006 and December 11, 2006 CTDEP conditional approvals regarding October 3, 2005 and November 15, 2006 Supplemental Scopes of Study.
- Submittal of supplemental investigation report regarding soil investigations at Hamden Housing Authority property;
- If CTDEP conditional approval is received, remediate PCB impacted soils located west of tennis courts and install additional monitoring wells southwest of Middle School Site for purposes of fully defining VOC impacts in ground water. The schedule for the work would be contingent on timing of the approval letter(s) and any potential conditions identified in the letter(s); and
- Continue participation in Public Involvement Plan.
