
Leggette, Brashears & Graham, Inc. (LBG), on behalf of South Central Connecticut Regional Water Authority (RWA), is providing notice that due to the Connecticut Department of Environmental Protection (CTDEP) verbal request on February 16, 2005 to collect additional soil samples to be analyzed for polynuclear aromatic hydrocarbon (PAH), dioxin and furans, we will be unable to include all results for dioxin and furan sampling in the Final Investigation Report and Evaluation of Remedial Alternative Report due on March 31, 2005. As you are aware, this request to complete additional investigations by the CTDEP was beyond that described in the approved April 16, 2004 "Supplemental Scope of Study, Former Hew Haven Water Company Property, Middle School Site Hamden, Connecticut" and subsequent addendum modifications which were issued pursuant to Consent Order No, SRD-128.

The additional field investigations included the recollection of samples at test boring locations completed during our 2002 investigation. These additional field investigations were completed on February 24 and 25, 2005. The samples are being analyzed for PAHs, and after review, for dioxins and furans. Currently, we are waiting on the results of the PAHs. Once we receive and review the results, we will send the appropriate samples to be additionally analyzed for dioxins and furans. Unfortunately, our estimate is that the dioxin and furan results will not be available until approximately 2 to 3 weeks after the March 31, 2005 submittal deadline. Considering we will not have these data, it will be necessary to submit an addendum to the above-referenced report. Because there is little benefit to make assessments on a partial set of data; we will be submitting the results and our analyses for all dioxin and furan analyses one month after we receive the latest dioxin and furan analyses. This will provide us sufficient time

to adequately analyze all the dioxin and furan results and base our opinions on a complete set of data.
